

### Multimodal Project Checklist

*Note: This checklist is for planning purposes ONLY. This is NOT the application. We highly recommend that you draft your responses in a separate Word document and use the checklist below to make sure you have addressed all the requirements. Once finalized, you can copy your answers into the application form.*

1. **Project Output (15 words max):** State the expected output (e.g., podcast, game design/development, interactive website, comic, etc.).
2. **Project Title (15 words max).**
3. **Project Description (500 words max):** Briefly outline a) the central topic, i.e., what the story is about; b) why it matters; c) the research, i.e., how the data will be collected; d) a brief description of what the final product will look like; e) your multimodal approach, including the visual, sonic, or other stylistic choices you plan to make and how they will help convey your message; and f) the project's feasibility through a brief practical plan, including locations and access to characters or communities, and/or technical considerations.
4. **References:** Submit a Word document with 9 references. This should include **3 research sources** (e.g. journal articles, academic books, news articles) related to your topic + **3 multimodal projects** that address topics similar or related to your project + **3 multimodal references**, preferably similar outputs as your project, that inspire your intended storytelling, style, tone, or aesthetics.
5. **Format Justification (200 words max):** Explain why you chose the format. How does it best convey your story, fit the project's themes and audience, and help you communicate your ideas effectively?
6. **Elevator Pitch Video (ONE minute max):** Record a one-minute video pitching your project as you might over a short elevator ride. In your video, briefly explain what your project is about, why it matters, and why you are the best person to tell this story. Keep it clear and engaging. Share a *Google Drive* link to the video, with viewing access set to "Anyone with the link."
7. **Relevant Courses (250 words max):** List at least 3 courses you have taken that are relevant to your multimodal project. For each course, include title and number, instructor's name, AND brief description of how it has prepared you for this project. At least one of the courses you list should be a course directly related to the training required for your project. For example, if you are proposing to work on a podcast, multimedia project, or video game design, include classes directly relevant to the proposed medium.
8. **Relevant Experience (250 words max):** List experiences outside of class, such as an independent study, personal project, internship, or other initiatives, that add value to your proposed project. Describe your role and responsibilities, and how the skills you gained will support your project with #IAS\_NUQ.
9. **Are you applying for an ongoing project?** If so, please provide a summary of the current state of the project (150 words max).
10. **Contribution to #IAS\_NUQ's Mission (150 words max):** Specify how your project addresses our mission. For more information on our mission, please check the [#IAS\\_NUQ website](#).
11. **Contribution to #IAS\_NUQ's Themes (150 words max):** Which of the #IAS\_NUQ themes does your project address? Please engage with at least one of our current themes. For more information on our themes, please check the [#IAS\\_NUQ website](#).
12. **Language Skills (150 words max):** List the languages you speak, read, or write, and explain how they support your project.
13. **Preliminary Budget:** Provide projected research costs up to QAR 5000 (NOT including airfare). Divide it by accommodation, meals, and other research expenses to be incurred during the trip in Qatari Riyals.

14. **Other Funding:** List any other grants, fellowships, or funding (such as Summer Undergraduate Research Grant, Advanced Undergraduate Research on Robots and AI, or Summer Internship Grant Program) you plan to apply for between Dec 2026–Dec 2027. You must disclose all external funding to the IAS team. If none, type "N/A."
15. **Other Program Applications:** Will you be applying for JR or Comm Exchange for Spring 2027? This is just for our information.
16. **CV or Resume (2 pages max):** Attach your CV or resume (Name: FIRSTNAME\_LASTNAME\_RESUME).
17. **Portfolio (50 mb max):** Attach your portfolio here. If your file is larger than 50 mb, please upload a Word/PDF document with a link to your portfolio (Name it as FIRST NAME\_LAST NAME\_portfolio).
18. **Short Professional Bio (50 words max).**
